Priority Schools are schools that are scoring in the bottom 5% of the state based on TCAP data. HCS accomplished a first in TN achievement by removing 7 schools in 3 years from the priority list.

Blue Ribbon Schools are nationally recognized high-performing schools and schools making great strides in closing any achievement gaps between students.

Annual Measurable Objective is the improvement goal for each school and district.

Level 4 & 5 Schools are schools whose growth is outpacing the state average.

Reward Schools demonstrate high levels of performance and/or growth across all indicators.


ELPA Gap Closure Schools is when schools close gaps on the comprehensive English language proficiency assessment and instructional system designed to support English learners and their educators.


