1.	Driving to school is a privilege, not a right, and will be extended to students who follow proper procedures. Permission to drive to and from school may be revoked at any time when a student is found to abuse the privilege.
2.	Students must purchase a permit from Advisory teacher in order to park a car on the school campus. If a student withdraws or loses driving privileges, it will be grounds for the permit to be relinquished back to Central High School for resale. Students may not sell their parking space or permit nor let someone else park in their space.
3.	Any vehicle not registered will be given a warning. The second violation will result in a parent conference. THE THIRD VIOLATION WILL RESULT IN THE VEHICLE BEING TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE. Please follow all parking rules to avoid towing of a vehicle.
4.	Seniors will have 1st priority to purchase a permit; juniors will have next priority. The day after registration/orientation permits will be available on a first come first serve basis.
5.	If any spaces are available after seniors, juniors, and sophomores purchase permits, spaces left will be sold to freshman on an individual basis and certain criteria will be used to determine issuance of a permit.
6.	No student's car is to be parked in the teacher's parking lot or visitor spaces. (SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE TOWING).
7.	Cost of the permit is \$25.00. If a parking tag is lost, a new one must be purchased at full price.
8.	If a permit is purchased, the space is to be occupied with the owner's car a majority of the time.
9.	Park only in the space designated by the number on the parking hanger.
10.	All cars in the student parking area must have a tag visible through the window; if not, the car tag number will be recorded and a warning issued.
11.	All parking problems (loss of tag, failure to bring tag, car in space, etc.) should be reported immediately to the front office.
12.	Observe the 15 mph speed limit at all times, day or night.
13.	Cars are not to leave campus during the school day except for authorized dismissals. Violation of this rule could result in loss of permit.
14.	Please do not litter the parking lot.
15.	No loitering permitted in parking areas before, during or after school. Students must leave cars as soon as they arrive and not ENTER the parking lot during the school day unless permitted by an administrator.
16.	Excessive tardiness to school may result in loss of parking privileges.
17.	Cars parked on school grounds are subject to search at any time.
